About the Webinar :

‘NRI marriages’, as generally understood, are between an Indian woman from India and an Indian man residing in another country (thus NRI - non-resident Indian)

In the eagerness not to let go of such lucrative marriage offer, the families totally ignore even the common cautions that are observed in traditional matchmaking. They also ignore that in case of things going wrong in an NRI marriage, the woman’s recourse to justice is greatly constrained and complex. The aggravated risk in such marriage is the woman is being ‘isolated’ far away from home in an alien land, facing language constraints, communication problems, lack of proper information about the local criminal justice, police and legal system. The situation is worsened by lack of support network of friends and family and monetary constraints which leaves the deserted wife completely helpless and stranded.

This webinar aims create awareness among students regarding the **Issues and Concerns related to ‘NRI marriages’** particularly harmonizing domestic laws with international private laws.

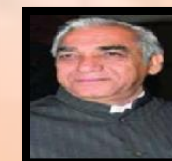
