DIRECTION NO. 28 OF 2022

Constitution of the Boards of Studies in the University, Direction, 2022.

Whereas, the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Maharashtra Act No. VI of 2017), (hereinafter Act VI of 2017) has come into force with effect from 1st March 2017 and the same is being made applicable to the Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj University Nagpur (hereinafter the University),

AND

Whereas, by virtue of the provisions of section 34 of the Act No.VI of 2017, the Universities governed by the said Act shall have only four faculties namely:-

- I Faculty of Science and Technology;
- II Faculty of Commerce and Management;
- III Faculty of Humanities; and
- IV Faculty of Inter-disciplinary Studies;

AND

Whereas, as per section 40 of the Act No.VI of 2017 there shall be Board of Studies for every subject or a group of subjects, comprised in the various faculties of the University, to be created by a statute.

AND

Whereas, various Boards of studies were provided for the different faculties of the Universities which were in existence prior to the coming into force of the Act VI of 2017, under Statute 23 of the University;

AND

Whereas, with the reorganization of the erstwhile faculties of the University under newly created four faculties under the Maharashtra Act No.VI of 2017, some of the provisions of the Statute 23 of the University has become inconsistent with the provisions of the Maharashtra Act No.VI of 2017 and therefore the said

statute is also required to be amended, necessitating promulgation of Direction under section 12(8) to amend the said Statute as making a fresh statute is a time consuming process and the elections to the Board of studies are due in near future;

AND

Whereas, there was an urgency in the matter of constitution of Boards of Studies in the four different faculties of the University as the elections to the Boards of the Studies were required to be conducted by the University within stipulated time;

AND

Whereas, the framing of the statute is a time consuming process and sub-section (8) of section 12 of the Act No.VI of 2017 confers power on the Vice Chancellor to issue Directions for regulating the matters which are to be regulated by the statutes;

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council of the University in its meeting dated 27th June 2017 while accepting the directions of the state government contained in its letter no. संकीर्ण-२०१७/प्र.क्र. २७९/विशी-३, उच्च व तंत्र शिक्षण विभाग, Dated 22nd June 2017 regarding composition of the four different faculties in the university under the Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016 had also given certain guidelines with respect to the composition of the Boards of Studies in the University and also the Advisory Committee constituted for the purpose of advising the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar for the smooth conduct of elections to various bodies and authorities of the university recommended to constitute the new Boards of studies keeping in mind the provisions of Statute 23 of the University, as amended from time to time;

AND

Whereas, Direction No. 3 of 2020 was issued by the Vice-Chancellor on-4.2.2020 Which could not be converted into the Statute within Six months and hence the said Direction is now lapsed by virtue of the provision of the proviso to section 12(8) of the Act, and being satisfied about urgency, in order to conduct the elections to the Board of Studies;

Now, therefore, I, Dr. Subhash R. Chaudhari, Vice-Chancellor of the University, being satisfied about there being exigency to issue the Direction for constitution of various Boards of Studies in the University, as contemplated by section 40 of the Act No. VI of 2017, do hereby issue the following Direction in exercise of my powers under sub-section (8) of section 12 of the Act No. VI of 2017, keeping in mind the decision of the State Government, decision of the Academic Council and recommendations of the Advisory Committee;

1. This Direction may be called, "Constitution of Boards of Studies in the University, Direction, 2022".
2. This Direction shall come into force from the date of its issuance.
3. On issuance of this Direction Statute no. 23 of the University shall stand amended accordingly.
4. There shall be Boards of Studies, comprising different subject or subjects, under the four different faculties of the University as shown in the table, entitled "Boards of Studies in the University", given below:-


