REPORT

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON "ANTI-RAGGING LAWS IN INDIA"

on 09-08-2024 at 9:30 am

Post Graduate Teaching Department of Law (Autonomous), RTMNU organized an awareness lecture on the topic of "**Anti-Ragging Laws in India**" on 9th August 2024 at 9.30 am in the department premises. Mrs. Shikha Gupta, Faculty, PGTD Law, RTMNU was invited as resource person to enlighten the students on this topic. Ms. Sakshi, student of PGTD of Law, RTMNU formally introduced the resource person and Dr. Payal Thaorey, Head PGTD of Law welcomed the guest speaker. In her theme setting remark, Dr. Thaorey explained the objective of educating students and faculty about the legal framework, consequences, and preventive measures associated with ragging in educational institutions and also shared information about Departmental Anti Ragging Committee. This lecture was attended by over 90 students, non-teaching staff and faculties of the PGTD Law.

The eminent speaker commenced her session with historical context with respect to actions of ragging, various myths & actual facts, psychological and physical impact it has on students, and the dire current scenario in country. Mrs. Gupta shared various reported incidences of the ragging at medical colleges and other respectable institutions. In its legal context, "Ragging is understood as a systematic human rights abuse exerted by seniors over juniors to establish dominance and is inclusive of verbal abuse, physical abuse, psychological abuse, sexual abuse, forceful drug abuse; direct or indirect", she added. A thorough explanation by the resource

person also covered basic statistical data that, “UGC received 4000 complaints in last 5 years through helpline, highest number of cases are found engineering and medical education institutions” & in such a scenario role of Raghavan committee’s notable contribution to identify ragging as a criminal act and establish a legal system was put forth the audience.

For a practical understanding she demonstrated with examples that actions of ragging are generally confused with general day to day actions but it helped the students to understand that simple forceful daily life chores such as completion of projects, personal work, practice and styles varying person to person or group to group, making juniors dance uncomfortably, overburdening with work, following certain unreasonable rules etc. which may look like bonding also amounts as ragging. She identified the possible place such as hostels, classrooms, canteen, educational tours as well where one may face instances of ragging and urged students not to bear neither commit any such act of ragging and added that reporting of ragging incidences is duty of individual as well as institutions.

In her concluding remark she specified clearly that ragging shall not be accepted as tradition and everyone must develop zero tolerance against such actions. Ragging awareness, anti ragging cells, helpline, inclusion in NCERT and SCERT school books, exemplary punishments to perpetrators, inclusion in BNSS under sec 296, 126 127, 351 are some initiatives curbing the incidences of the issue. A student found guilty may be expelled from institutions, banned to enter from premises, cancellation of educational facilities so received etc. The speaker urged students to report the incidence as victim or even as vigilant member of society, to head of your institution, not to live in isolation, call anti ragging helpline (18001805522) and not to commit any such practice at all.

In an interactive session, a student shared his own experience of ragging at previously enrolled institutions. Another question was if junior can be charged for ragging, and the speaker clarified that it will amount to criminal act under BNS not ragging per se.
