- The selection of PGTD programme for clustering shall be made on the basis of partial matching of pre-requisite knowledge.
- E.g. the course Name "Experimental Techniques For Materials characterization", on the
 basis of pre-requisite and syllabus of the course, it can be availed by PG students of
 chemistry, biotechnology, microbiology, physics, pharmaceutical sciences etc. So, these
 departments can be clustered to implement this course under CBCS.

- IQAC will coordinate awareness programme for newly joined semester-I for such courses and there importance for future academic and research carrier.
