- (ii) Henceforth, the Central Universities shall execute the building projects after the approval from the University Building Committee, Finance Committee, and Executive Council by mandatorily following the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 as well as instruction of GFR 130 to 141 pertaining to the execution of the works including CPWD Work Manual and CVC Guidelines.
- (iii) All the Central Universities should be informed accordingly; from now onwards there is no need to send the proposal to UGC for seeking approval for the Building Projects.
